SUSTAINED / WESSA

Assessments of Portfolios - A lot of attention has been given to all the portfolios of evidence (PoE's) that were submitted for the many training courses that SustainEd and other WESSA regions have run over the past year. (See the details on the right) Congratulations to the Free State region and Port Elizabeth for running the Enviro. Eds. course for the first time.

Assessor Course – in November SustainEd ran an assessor course at which **LEARNING THROUGH NATURE** was asked to co-facilitate.



The Environmental Practices – Nine Level 2
Skills Programmes were held in KZN with all groups completing 5 modules. These groups were – uMshwathi (Wartburg), Ulundi, Okhahlamba (Bergville), uMkhanyakude (Mkuze), Nongoma, eDumbe (Paulpietersburg), Kokstad, uMvoti and a group form DUCT. The same course was run in the western and southern Cape (Cape Town, Hermanus and George) and is known as the DEA YES course. In total 220 learners registered for this course. A new course has just begun with 15 learners form Uitenhage involved in the Working for Water programme.

The Environmental Education Training and Development Practices (EETDP) Fifteen learners participated in the Level 5 qualification which was completed at the end of 2013.

Second assessments have been done of PoE's for the 2011/2012 **EETDP** course run by WESSA Western Cape in which 15 learners participated.

Ten learners participated in the DELP (Developing an Environmental Learning Programme) course. This is Module 3 of the EETDP course which is run as a stand-alone course.

Twelve Environmental Educators Courses were run throughout the country. This popular course was run in Cape Town, two courses in East London (Border-Kei region), Free State, Nelspruit, Bushpigs (Gauteng region), Port Elizabeth, Twinstreams (Umtunzini), Treasure Beach (Durban), a special course for the Groen Sebenza interns, Umgeni Valley (January and November). A total of 136 learners submitted PoE's.
